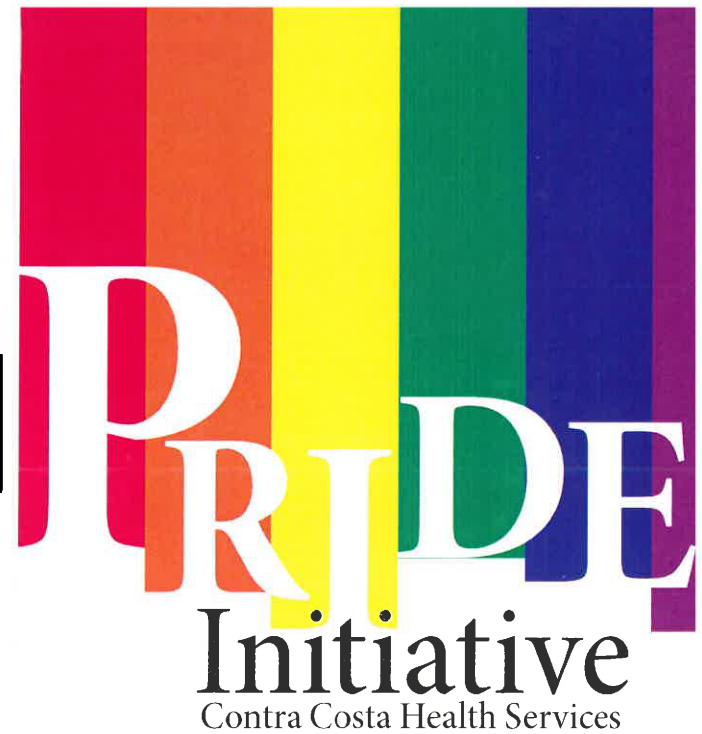

- 🏳️‍🌈 CCHS PRIDE flies Transgender Day of Remembrance flag in CCRMC and Public Health, November 2012.
- 🏳️‍🌈 CCHS PRIDE sponsors Board of Supervisors proclaiming June as LGBT Pride month, 2010–2013.
- 🏳️‍🌈 CCHS PRIDE collaborates in the development of the Nondiscrimination, Cultural Competency, and Welcoming policies for Contra Costa Health Services, 2011–on-going.
