To Achieve Full LGBTQ Inclusion

The HRC Foundation's All Children – All Families Webinar Series includes 20 offerings in five topical tracks. The series runs from August 2018 to March 2019. All webinars are available at no cost.

TRACK 1: CORE CURRICULUM

The "Core Curriculum Track" includes three 90-minute webinars and each will be presented live monthly. Topics include foundational information on LGBTQ competency and in-depth information for serving LGBTQ youth and LGBTQ parents. These webinars are suggested prerequisites for the "LGBTQ Parent" and "LGBTQ Youth" tracks.

Each webinar is eligible for 1.5 CEs from the National Association of Social Workers.

TRACK 2: BEST PRACTICES IN SERVING LGBTQ PARENTS

The "LGBTQ Parent Track" focuses on issues most applicable to those in parent-serving roles. A specific topic is presented each month, including LGBTQ parent recruitment, conducting LGBTQ-affirming homestudies, and promising practices with trans and non-binary parents. Each webinar is 60 minutes.

Pre-Requisites: "Introduction to LGBTQ Competency" and "Best Practices for Serving LGBTQ Parents" Core Curriculum webinars (or their equivalent).

TRACK 3: BEST PRACTICES IN SERVING LGBTQ YOUTH

The "LGBTQ Youth Track" focuses on issues most applicable to those in youth-serving roles. A specific topic is presented each month, including the latest research on LGBTQ youth, supporting bisexual and pansexual youth and resources for HIV prevention. Each webinar is 60 minutes.

Pre-Requisites: "Introduction to LGBTQ Competency" and "Best Practices for Serving LGBTQ Youth" Core Curriculum webinars (or their equivalent).

TRACK 4: CARING FOR LGBTQ YOUTH (FOR CAREGIVERS)

This 60-minute webinar is designed specifically for foster parents and other caregivers who are looking to best meet the needs of LGBTQ youth.

This webinar is offered in both English and Spanish.

TRACK 5: LGBTQ INCLUSION STRATEGIES FOR AGENCY LEADERSHIP

The "Leadership Track" focuses on issues most applicable to those in leadership roles at agencies. Topics include a briefing on LGBTQ inclusion tailored to agency executives, creating an LGBTQ-inclusive workplace, and public policy advocacy. Each webinar is 60 minutes.

All agencies officially participating in ACAF must have at least one leader attend an Executive Briefing.
