Pursuant to North Carolina Public Records Law, G.S. §132-1., the Human Rights Campaign hereby requests material related to the non-discrimination questionnaires that were submitted to the NCAA, between April 2016 and the present, as part of the bidding process required by the NCAA Board of Governors to host NCAA events.

The Human Rights Campaign requests the completed questionnaires submitted to the NCAA, as well as letters, memos, emails, text messages, phone records, scheduling records, and other communication between school officials and representatives of the NCAA.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me if the cost will exceed \$250. However, we would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of the state's non-discrimination policies.
