Under the North Carolina Public Records Law, G.S. §132-1., I am requesting an opportunity to inspect or obtain copies of public records (as defined in G.S. §132-1(a)) that show all correspondence and communication between Governor Patrick McCrory's office and the Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF), or any attorneys working on behalf of or representing the Alliance Defending Freedom, between any executive branches of government and the Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF), or any attorneys working on behalf of or representing the Alliance Defending Freedom, and between any legislative branch of government and the Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF), or any attorneys working on behalf of or representing the Alliance Defending Freedom.

Second, I am requesting all available correspondence and communication between Governor Patrick McCrory's office and the North Carolina Values Coalition, or any attorneys working on behalf of or representing the North Carolina Values Coalition, between any executive branches

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of government and the North Carolina Values Coalition, or any attorneys working on behalf of or representing the North Carolina Values Coalition, and between any legislative branch of government and the North Carolina Values Coalition, or any attorneys working on behalf of or representing the North Carolina Values Coalition.

Third, I am requesting all correspondence and communication regarding H.B. #2, The Public Facilities Privacy & Security Act between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and any executive branch of government, between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and the North Carolina General Assembly, including North Carolina House Speaker Timothy Moore, between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and the North Carolina State Senate, including Senate President Phil Berger, between any executive branch of government and the North Carolina General Assembly, including North Carolina House Speaker Timothy Moore, and between any executive branch of government and the North Carolina State Senate, including North Carolina Senate President Phil Berger.

Fourth, I am requesting all correspondence and communications regarding changes affecting N.C. Gen. Stat. Sec. 143-422 between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and any executive branch of government, between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and the North Carolina General Assembly, including North Carolina House Speaker Timothy Moore, between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and the North Carolina State Senate, including Senate President Phil Berger, between any executive branch of government and the North Carolina General Assembly, including North Carolina House Speaker Timothy Moore, and between any executive branch of government and the North Carolina State Senate, including North Carolina Senate President Phil Berger.

Fifth, I am requesting all correspondence and communications regarding access to restrooms, locker rooms, and other sex-segregated facilities between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and any executive branch of government, between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and the North Carolina General Assembly, including North Carolina House Speaker Timothy Moore, between the office of Governor Patrick McCrory and the North Carolina State Senate, including Senate President Phil Berger, between any executive branch of government and the North Carolina General Assembly, including North Carolina House Speaker Timothy Moore, and between any executive branch of government and the North Carolina State Senate, including North Carolina Senate President Phil Berger.

Finally, I am requesting all correspondence and communications regarding municipalities or local government entities that have local laws, ordinances or regulations which include legal protections for characteristics not otherwise covered by state law, including but not limited to veterans and lesbian, gay, bisexual and/or transgender individuals (collectively, "Protective Ordinances") between the office of Governor McCrory and any executive branch of government, between Governor McCrory and any legislative branch of government, and between any executive branch of government and any legislative branch of government. . Please identify

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legal counsel consulted on Protective Ordinances and on the drafting of H.B. 2. Please provide copies of all Protective Ordinances in the possession of such legal counsel or which were reviewed by such legal counsel.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me if the cost will exceed \$50. However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of passage H.B. #2. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.

The law requires that you respond to and fulfill this request "as promptly as possible." If you expect a significant delay in responding to and fulfilling this request, please contact me with information about when I might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law.
