APPLICATION DEADLINES:

August 5th, 2019: National HBCU Leadership Summit application opens online.

September 4th, 2019: National HBCU Leadership Summit Application closes at 11:59pm EST.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THE NATIONAL LEADERSHIP SUMMIT?

- All LGBTQ undergraduate students currently attending a Historically Black College/University
- Students with proven academic achievement
- Students who are current leaders and/or looking to promote LGBTQ inclusion, equity and engagement on their campus and in the community
- Students who are committed to social justice, servant-leadership, and community organizing

WHAT IS THE APPLICATION PROCESS?

- Application Completion and Deadline
- Action Plan Form (to be completed by Semifinalists)
- Phone Interview (to be completed by Semifinalists)
- Acceptance/Denial notifications (no later than Friday, September 20)

WHERE ARE THE LODGING ACCOMMODATIONS?

- All students will be staying in [The Beacon Hotel in Washington, D.C.](#)

WHAT ARE THE ROOMING LOGISTICS?

- If accepted, you will room with another student leader of the same gender identity, regardless of sex/gender assigned at birth

HOW MUCH WILL I HAVE TO PAY?

- HRCF's HBCU Program covers expenses regarding travel, lodging and meals.
**Students will be required to pay any applicable baggage fees, and be required to have a credit or debit card on file at the Beacon Hotel for any incidentals occurring during the summit.*

WILL EXCUSE NOTES BE PROVIDED?

- Excuse notes will be provided directly to the students as well as submitted to your HBCUs: Vice President for Student Affairs or Director for Student Life and Activities/Leadership

DO I HAVE TO ATTEND EVERY SINGLE DAY OF THE NATIONAL LEADERSHIP SUMMIT?

- Yes, in order to attend the National HBCU Leadership Summit, you are required to attend **all** five days of the summit.

Transportation will be arranged for students to arrive in Washington, DC on Thursday, November 7, and return to their campus on Tuesday, November 12.
