The mission of the OHSU Transgender Health Program is to provide safe, comprehensive, affirming health care for the transgender and gender-nonconforming communities. We want to improve the community's overall well-being through education, research and leadership that responds to the health care needs of transgender and gender nonconforming people.

The Transgender Health Program is continuously working to identify medical providers who can address the specific health needs of transgender patients, provide trainings on transgender health for OHSU medical providers and staff, establish best practices and protocols for transition specific and other transgender medical services, review and develop policy to support an inclusive environment and offer direct support to transgender employees.

OHSU's current medical services for transgender people include:

- Pubertal suppressants
- Hormone replacement therapy
- Chest reconstruction
- Breast augmentation
- Orchiectomy
- Hysterectomy/Oophorectomy

Surgical service is expected to expand in 2016 to include:

- Facial Feminization
- Vulvoplasty/Labiaplasty
- Vaginoplasty
- Phalloplasty
- Metoidioplasty
- Penectomy

Non-medical services for transgender people at OHSU include:

- Information and referral
- Accompaniment and support for medical visits
- Coaching and support for transgender employees, including those transitioning at work
