

- Working in coalition with civil rights allies to fight voter suppression and white nationalism, support immigrants and refugees and more.
- Working to end the HIV epidemic by advocating for culturally responsive prevention and treatment, focusing on the most impacted, including Black and Latinx gay and bisexual men and transgender women.

- Amplifying the voices of racially diverse young queer changemakers through the HRC Youth Ambassador Program.
- Addressing bias-based bullying in the classroom, including race-based bullying.
- Sharing best practices with international LGBTQ advocates and joining together to speak out on human rights atrocities.
- Working to end the epidemic of fatal violence directed at transgender and non-binary people, which disproportionally impacts transgender women of color.
