# WELCOME FROM HRC PRESIDENT

#### Dear Friends,

Today, everything we've fought for, and everything we're still fighting for, is on the line – and we're not backing down a single inch.

We face a president and a Congress that stand opposed to our most fundamental values, and a wave of hateful bills in state legislatures across the country. In a majority of states, LGBTO people remain at risk of being fired, evicted, or denied services simply because of who they are. Our community -- particularly transgender people -- still faces a scourge of hate violence, made more deadly by unfettered access to guns. Young people continue to struggle against high rates of bullying, homelessness, and violence just because of who they are. And we have yet to end the spread of HIV despite having the tools and technology to achieve an AIDS-free generation.

But thanks to you, HRC is leading the way forward.

We've launched HRC Rising – the largest grassroots expansion in our 37-year history. With your support, we're growing our army of 3 million members and supporters in critical states across the country. And we're turning our focus and resources toward electing more pro-equality candidates up and down the ballot in 2018 and 2020.

We are also at the forefront of the fight in Congress for the Equality Act -- historic federal legislation that would finally end the unacceptable patchwork of non-discrimination laws across this country that threaten the livelihoods of LGBTQ Americans.

We're standing up to any attempt by Donald Trump, Mike Pence, and antiequality members of Congress to rollback our hard-won gains. And as our opponents work to pass legislation in states across the country targeting LGBTQ people, we're working to defeat hateful bills that attack the transgender community and put state economies in peril.

HRC is also expanding the frontiers of our fight for equality through programs like Project One America, which is moving equality forward in the Deep South. Our work through HRC Global is helping to build partnerships with our allies abroad to strengthen the global equality movement. We're expanding the groundbreaking work of the HRC Foundation -- which educates and helps build better, more inclusive communities for LGBTQ people in workplaces, classrooms, hospitals and churches -- everywhere from the town hall to the corporate board room.

Most of all, we're working to break down the walls of hate and discrimination that continue to hold us back, and put too many at risk. Our grassroots army – all of you -- has proven that, even in the face of unprecedented challenges, we can make incredible progress when we mobilize and organize. The power and determination of the 10 million LGBTQ voters and our allies across America will only continue to grow stronger in the face of discriminatory attacks on our rights and freedoms.

It's simply not enough to resist the hateful policies and attacks coming from the Trump-Pence administration – we must also accelerate the pace of progress toward full equality and secure protections for LGBTQ people in states and communities across the country.

At a time like this, we don't slow down -we double down, undeterred and focused
on our mission to realize a world in which
every single LGBTQ person is safe and
equal and valued. Your support has
allowed HRC to reach new heights. By
standing with us, you make us stronger.
And together, there is nothing we can't
achieve.

# HILLARY **RODHAM CLINTON**

illary Rodham Clinton has spent four decades in public service as an advocate, attorney, First Lady, U.S. Senator, U.S. Secretary of State, and presidential candidate.

Hillary Clinton was born in Chicago, Illinois on October 26, 1947. After graduating from Wellesley College and Yale Law School, she began her life-long work on behalf of children and families by joining the Children's Defense Fund. In 1974, she moved to Arkansas, where she married Bill Clinton and became a successful attorney while also raising their daughter, Chelsea. During her 12 years as First Lady of Arkansas, she was Chairwoman of the Arkansas Education Standards Committee, co-founded the Arkansas Advocates for Children and Families, and served on the boards of the Arkansas Children's Hospital, and the Children's Defense Fund.

As First Lady of the United States, from 1993 to 2001, Hillary Clinton championed health care for all Americans and led successful bipartisan efforts to improve the adoption and foster care systems, reduce teen pregnancy, and create the Children's Health Insurance Program. She traveled to more than 80 countries standing up for human rights, democracy, and civil society. Her speech in Beijing in 1995 - where she declared that "human rights are women's rights, and women's rights are human rights" inspired women worldwide and helped galvanize a global movement for women's rights and opportunities.

In 2000, Clinton made history as the first First Lady elected to the United States Senate, and the first woman elected to statewide office in New York. As senator, she worked across party lines to expand economic opportunity and access to quality, affordable health care. After the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, she secured funding to rebuild New York and provide health care for first responders who risked their lives working at Ground Zero. She also championed the cause of our nation's military and fought for better health care and benefits for wounded service members, veterans, and members of the National Guard and Reserves. In 2006, Clinton was reelected to the Senate, winning 58 out of New York's 62 counties.

In 2007, she began her historic campaign for president, winning 18 millions votes and becoming the first woman to ever win a presidential primary or caucus state. In the 2008 general election, she campaigned for Barack Obama and Joe Biden, and in December, she was nominated by President-elect Obama to be Secretary of State.

In her four years as America's chief diplomat and the President's principal foreign policy adviser, Clinton played a central role in restoring America's standing in the world and strengthening its global leadership, visiting 112 countries over four years, restoring America's standing in the world. Her "smart power" approach to foreign policy elevated American diplomacy and development and repositioned them for the 21st century - with new tools, technologies, and partners, including the private sector and civil society around the world. She led the effort to impose crippling sanctions on Iran, laying the foundation for a historic agreement to curb its nuclear program, and negotiated a ceasefire between Israel and Hamas that prevented a new war in the Middle

Across the world, she defended universal values and pushed the frontiers of human

In 2016, Clinton made history again by becoming the first woman nominated for president by a major U.S. political party. As the Democratic candidate for president, she campaigned on a vision of America that is "stronger together" and an agenda to make our economy work for everyone, not just those at the top. She won the national popular vote, earning the support of nearly 66 million Americans.

Hillary Rodham Clinton is the author of six best-selling books, including her groundbreaking book on children, "It Takes A Village" (1996); "Dear Socks, Dear Buddy" (1998); An Invitation to the White House (2000); her memoir, Living History (2003); Hard Choices (2014); and What Happened (2017). She and President Clinton reside in New York, have one daughter, Chelsea, and are the proud grandparents of Charlotte and Aidan.



# U.S. SEN. **KAMALA HARRIS**

lifelong public safety and civil rights leader, U.S. Senator Kamala D. Harris was the first African-American and first woman to serve as Attorney General of California and the second African-American woman to be elected to the United States Senate in history.

Throughout her career as a prosecutor, Harris was a tireless advocate for the most voiceless and vulnerable Californians.

As California's Attorney General, Harris prosecuted transnational gangs exploiting women and children and trafficking in guns and drugs and led comprehensive studies on the impacts of transnational criminal organizations and human trafficking in California.

Harris fought for Californians hit hardest during the state and national mortgage crisis, won \$20 billion for homeowners, created a multidivisional Mortgage Fraud Strike Force to crack down on fraud and passed the "Homeowners Bill of Rights," establishing the nation's most comprehensive anti-foreclosure protections.

Harris has worked intensively to protect children and students. She established California's Bureau of Children's Justice and fought to reduce elementary school truancy so that every California child can exercise his or her constitutional right to an education. As Attorney General, Harris successfully sued predatory for-profit colleges scamming students and veterans.

Harris aggressively defended the rights of consumers. She won major settlements for consumers, forged innovative agreements with the technology industry to improve privacy protections and cracked down on piracy and online crime. Harris also fought to protect California's environment, prosecuted polluters, helped win marriage equality for all Californians and defended the Affordable Care Act.

Throughout her career, Harris has been a leading advocate for innovation and reform in the criminal justice system. Harris worked to increase the adoption of technology and data-driven policing to assist law enforcement in the efficient investigation and prosecution of crime, established the first Office of

Recidivism Reduction and Reentry and pioneered the nation's first open data initiative to expose racial disparities in the criminal justice system.

Harris served two terms as District Attorney of San Francisco. Defeating a two-term incumbent, she was first elected DA in 2003, and was overwhelmingly elected to a second term in November 2007.

Harris began her career in the Alameda County District Attorney's Office, where she specialized in prosecuting child sexual assault cases. In 1998, she joined the San Francisco District Attorney's Office, where she led the Career Criminal Unit. She also served as the head of the San Francisco City Attorney's Division on Children and Families.

Born in Oakland, California, Harris is a graduate of Howard University, America's oldest historically black university. She received her law degree from the University of California, Hastings College of the Law. She is married to Doug Emhoff and is the author of the book Smart on Crime: A Career Prosecutor's Plan to Make Us Safer.



## **JEFFREY P. BEZOS**

#### NATIONAL EQUALITY AWARD

eff Bezos founded Amazon.com in 1994. Amazon's mission is to be Earth's most customer-centric company. Amazon offers low prices and fast delivery on millions of items, designs and builds the bestselling Kindle hardware, and empowers companies and governments in over 190 countries around the world

with the leading cloud computing infrastructure through its Amazon Web Services offering. Bezos is also the founder of aerospace company Blue Origin, which is working to lower the cost and increase the safety of spaceflight so that humans can better continue exploring the solar system.

Bezos graduated summa cum laude, Phi Beta Kappa in electrical engineering and computer science from Princeton University in 1986, and was named TIME Magazine's Person of the Year in 1999.



### **UZO ADUBA**

#### ALLY FOR EQUALITY AWARD

formidable talent to be reckoned with, Uzo Aduba is an awardwinning actress whose work spans television, film and theatre.

Aduba currently stars as Suzanne "Crazy Eyes" Warren in the critically acclaimed Netflix Original Series "Orange Is the New Black." Her performance has garnered a sweep of awards including the 2016 and 2015 SAG Award for "Best Actress in Comedy," the 2017 SAG Award nomination for "Best Actress in a Comedy," the 2015 Emmy Award for "Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Drama Series" and the 2014 Emmy Award for "Outstanding Guest Actress in a Comedy." In addition, Aduba was honored as part of the show's win in the category of "Best Ensemble in a Comedy" at the 2017, 2016 and 2015 SAG Awards. For her Emmy wins, Aduba joined Ed Asner to become only the second actor ever to win Emmys for the same role in the comedy and drama categories. Furthermore, with her SAG and Emmy honors, she became the first African-American actress to win the award in each category. She was also nominated for the 2015 and 2016 Golden Globe Award for "Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Series, Mini-Series, or TV Movie." The show will return for a sixth season in 2018.

In film, most recently, Aduba can be seen in Lionsgate and Hasbro's "My Little Pony" alongside Emily Blunt, Zoe Saldana, Liev Schreiber, Kristin Chenoweth, Taye Diggs and Sia. The film was released on October 6th. She was most recently seen in Ewan McGregor's "American Pastoral" alongside McGregor, Jennifer Connelly, and Dakota Fanning. The drama is based on the Pulitzer Prizewinning novel written by Philip Roth. Additionally, she appeared alongside Ellen Page and Allison Janey in Sian Heder's "Tallulah," which was released on Netflix in July 2016 after premiering at the 2016 Sundance Film Festival.

Also on television, Aduba appeared in NBC's 2015 musical production of "The Wiz Live!" as Glinda the Good Witch. Directed by Kenny Leon and produced by Neil Meron and Craig Zadan, the production also starred Queen Latifah, Mary J. Blige, Ne-Yo, Amber Riley, and David Alan Grier.

Aduba made her television debut in 2012 on the hit CBS show "Blue Bloods."

Before starring on television, Aduba made her Broadway debut in "Coram Boy" in 2007 followed by the hit musical revival of "Godspell" in 2011.

She discovered her talent for singing at a very early age and became a classical music major at the Boston University School of Fine Arts. Work in theatre quickly followed with critically acclaimed performances at both The Huntington Theatre in Boston and A.R.T. where, under the direction of Dianne Paulus, she won the prestigious Elliot Norton Award for Best Actress in a Play. She recently made her West End Theatre debut in The Jamie Lloyd Company's contemporary adaptation of Jean Genet's "The Maids." Directed by Lloyd, the play which also starred Laura Carmichael and Zawe Ashton.

Aduba was nominated for a Helen Hayes Award for Best Supporting Actress in a Play for her work in the Kennedy Center/ Olney Theater production of "Translations of Xhosa". Other theater credits include "Dessa Rose" at the New Repertory Theatre, "Turnado: Rumble for the Ring" at the Bay Street Theater and "Abyssinia" at the Goodspeed Theatre.

Past films include the independent shorts "Over There" and "Notes."

Aduba currently resides in New York City.



# **BILLIE JEAN KING**

#### SPECIAL GUEST

illie Jean King is the founder of the Billie Jean King Leadership Initiative and the co-founder of World TeamTennis. She has long been a champion for social change and equality. King created new inroads for men and women in sports and beyond during her legendary career and she continues to make her mark today.

King was named one of the '100 Most Important Americans of the 20th Century' by Life Magazine and, in 2009, in recognition of her work in the social justice arena and her accomplishments in sports, President Obama awarded her with the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the nation's highest civilian honor.

Born in Long Beach, California, she first played tennis at the age of 11 in the public parks of southern California. King won her first of a record 20 Wimbledon titles when she captured the 1961 Wimbledon Ladies' Doubles Championship with Karen Hantze. She went on to win 39 Grand Slam singles, doubles and mixed doubles titles during her career. On September 20, 1973, she empowered women and educated men when she defeated Bobby Riggs in one of the greatest moments in sports history - the Battle of the Sexes. This match is remembered for its effect on society and its contribution to the women's movement.

In 2014, in partnership with Teneo, she launched the Billie Jean King Leadership Initiative to address inclusion and diversity issues in the workplace. In 2016 she addressed both the National Football League and FIFA, the international governing body of soccer, on issues related to gender equality and inclusion.

In 2006 her accomplishments both on and off the court were recognized when the home of the U.S. Open was renamed the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center. In 2008 King released her first book in more than 20 years. Titled "Pressure is a Privilege", the book shares a collection of life lessons she has used throughout her life and career.

In 1974 King co-founded World Team Tennis (WTT), the revolutionary professional tennis league. Now in its 42nd season and known as Mylan World TeamTennis, WTT showcases the best in professional team tennis competing for the King Trophy.

King continues her life mission to help

the underserved, most notably through her efforts to provide programming and funding for those infected, affected or at risk of HIV & AIDS through her work with the Elton John AIDS Foundation (EJAF). A member of the organization's Board of Trustees, King has helped the organization raise more than \$385 million over the past 24 years in support or worthy programs in more than 55 countries around the world.

Since founding the Women's Sports Foundation in 1974, King has led the organization in its mission to advance the lives of girls and women through sports and physical activity. Since its inception, the Foundation has awarded more than \$50 million in educational and cash grants to advance participation, research and leadership in sports and physical activity for girls and women.

King also serves on the board of the Andy Roddick Foundation and is a past member of the President's Council on Fitness, Sports and Nutrition. In February 2014, King was named, by President Obama, to the Presidential Delegation to the Winter Olympics in Sochi, Russia.



# **KHIZR KHAN**

#### **SPECIAL GUEST**

hizr Khan moved to the United States with his wife, Ghazala, in 1980. The couple became American citizens and raised their three sons in Silver Spring, Maryland. Their middle son, US Army Captain Humayun Khan, a graduate of the University of Virginia and its Army ROTC program, was killed in 2004 while stopping a suicide attack near Baqubah, Iraq, and was posthumously awarded a Purple Heart and Bronze Star. Khizr Khan holds a BA degree from the University of the Punjab, and LL.B. from Punjab University Law College, and an LL.M. from Harvard Law School. He is a member of the Bar of the Supreme

Court of the United States, the District of Columbia Bar, the New York State Bar, and the American Bar Association. Khan's law practice includes complex civil litigation, electronic discovery, health privacy compliance law, and civil rights and veterans' rights advocacy. He and Ghazala live in Charlottesville, Virginia.



# TAYLOR SCHILLING

#### SPECIAL GUEST

aylor Schilling is an Emmy and Golden Globe-nominated actress who currently stars in the Netflix original series, "Orange is the New Black," as the lead Piper Chapman. Schilling stars opposite Uzo Aduba, Kate Mulgrew, Natasha Lyonne and Laura Prepon.

Recently, Schilling completed production for "FAM-I-LY" directed by Laura Steinel and for "The Public" directed by Emilio Estevez. Both films will be released in 2018.

In 2017, Schilling starred in the film, "Take Me" as Anna St. Blair. The film released on May 5, 2017.

In 2016, Schilling completed production on "The Titan," opposite Sam Worthington and Tom Wilkinson. The Titan," is set in a not-too-distant future and it tracks the journey of a military family that is relocated to take part in a groundbreaking experiment of man's genetic evolution into space.

In 2015, Schilling also appeared in

Patrick Brice's "The Overnight," alongside Adam Scott and Jason Schwartzman. The film premiered at the 2015 Sundance Film Festival on January 23, 2015 and its distribution rights were subsequently acquired by The Orchard. "The Overnight" also premiered at the South by Southwest Film Festival on March 14, 2015 and the Tribeca Film Festival on April 21, 2015. The film was released in theaters on June 26, 2015.

Earlier that same year, Schilling completed her limited engagement run in the Classic Stage Company production of "A Month in the Country," opposite Peter Dinklage. The play ran from January 9, 2015 - February 28, 2015.

In 2012, Schilling appeared in the Academy Award winning film "Argo." She starred opposite Affleck, Bryan Cranston and John Goodman in the film that centers on the real-life C.I.A. plan to rescue a group of diplomats from Tehran after the 1979 Iranian revolution by claiming that they were part of a Hollywood movie crew shooting a film.

Schilling played Christine Mendez, the wife of Affleck's character. The film was released on October 12, 2012.

Earlier in 2012, Schilling starred opposite Zac Efron in Scott Hicks' highly anticipated Warner Brothers film "The Lucky One." The film is based on the Nicholas Sparks novel about a Marine (Efron) who survives three tours in Iraq and attributes his good fortune to a photograph he carried of a woman he has never met (Schilling), whom he sets out to meet upon his return to North Carolina. "The Lucky One" was released on April 20, 2012.

Taylor grew up in Massachusetts and graduated in 2006 from Fordham University with a Bachelor of Arts in Acting. She entered New York University's Graduate Acting Program and left after her second year to pursue her acting career, landing MERCY, an NBC drama, within four months.

She currently resides in New York City.



ormed in the summer of 2015, DNCE first introduced themselves to audiences worldwide with the release of "Cake By The Ocean," their now 3x certified platinum-selling breakout smash. Included on the group's 2016 self-titled debut album [Republic Records], "Cake By The Ocean" entered the Top 10 on the Billboard Hot 100 chart and became a hit at Top 40 radio, where it went on to become one of the most played songs of the year. After returning to the states, Goldberg began competing in festivals and competitions all over the country. She was one of five national finalists to perform in the "Wendy's Good Taste Comedy Challenge" produced by HBO and TBS in Las Vegas, Nevada as part of The Comedy Festival. In 2005 Goldberg was chosen out of thousands of comedians to participate in the San Francisco International Comedy

Competition. In three short years, she was invited to New York City to share the stage with powerhouse comedians Roz G, Laurie Kilmartin and Judy Gold for the 17th Annual Comedy Hour at Caroline's On Broadway on behalf of the Ms. Foundation and Gloria Steinem. Since her explosive start, Goldberg has performed in clubs and theaters all over the country, graced two national magazine covers, and performed in 23 states and 7 countries.

In 2006, just three years after she stepped onto the stage for the first time, Goldberg put on a producer's hat and started the Annual Southwest Funnyfest in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Each year Goldberg hosts the night of comedy to help benefit New Mexico AIDS Services (NMAS). She brings the best national female headlining comics to the Land of Enchantment for a night of non-stop, no holds barred, side splitting comedy. Since its inception, the Funnyfest has helped to raise close to \$20,000 for NMAS and has brought in over a dozen comedians from The Tonight Show with Jay Leno, Comedy Central, Late Night With Craig Ferguson, Last Comic Standing, and Comics Unleashed.

In the summer of 2009, Goldberg starred in her comedy special "One Night Stand Up: Episode 4" on the LOGO network; filmed at the Great American Music Hall in San Francisco. Later that year she recorded

her debut DVD "Hot And Bothered: Dana Goldberg Live" in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Emmy Award winning comedian David Brenner raves, "One of the best ways to beat the recession is with laughs, and Dana Goldberg offers you one of your best chances to get some in her debut DVD." After moving to Los Angeles in the fall of 2009, Goldberg found a new comedy home and it wasn't long before she was headlining nights at world famous clubs like The Laugh Factory and the LA Improv.

Goldberg continues to combine her gift of humor with humanitarian efforts raising significant funds to fight HIV & AIDS and joins LGBT communities and organizations across the country to raise national awareness in the fight for equality. Since joining the Human Rights Campaign family in 2009, Goldberg has headlined comedy nights and assisted in live auctions for HRC events across the country in more than a dozen cities. In addition to her hilarious comedy and side-splitting performances, Goldberg has shared the national stage with President Barack Obama, Jane Lynch and the cast of GLEE, Lady Gaga, Kathy Griffin, Portia de Rossi, Judy Gold, David Brenner and Kathy Najimy. As the youngest child in a single-parent household run by a Jewish mother in which two of three kids are gay, Goldberg helps keep most of the comedy venues and half of the psychotherapists in the country in business.



The Human Rights Campaign celebrates the incredible life and legacy of Edith "Edie" Windsor, who passed away on September 12, 2017 at the age of 88.

As a leader and icon in the fight for marriage equality, Edie became a hero to millions as a plaintiff in the landmark Supreme Court *United States v. Windsor* case that successfully defeated the Defense of Marriage Act and granted federal recognition to same-sex couples in 2013.

Because of Edie's persistence and bravery, her case helped pave the way for the 2015 Supreme Court case, *Obergefell* 

v. Hodges, that granted nationwide marriage equality and announced to the world that love is love, and love wins.

Her advocacy extended well beyond the Supreme Court case and her passion helped change hearts and minds across the country and around the world.

Her tireless efforts in the quest for full equality gave us hope and helped blaze the trail for countless Americans.

Thank you, Edie, for inspiring a generation. Your legacy will live on forever.
