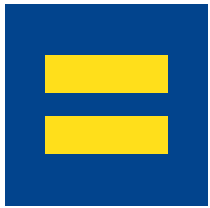

Silent Auction

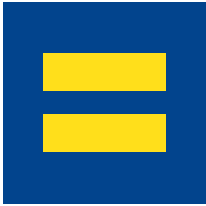
